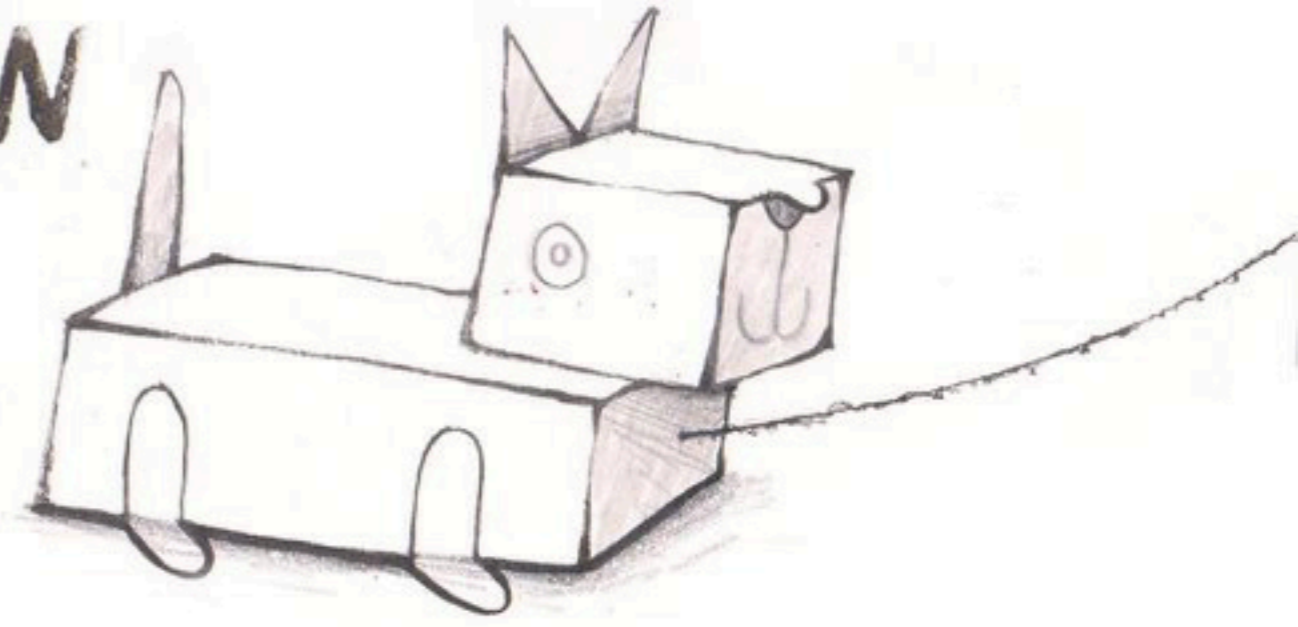




# Dog Show

2. Bring your dogs to the dog show.

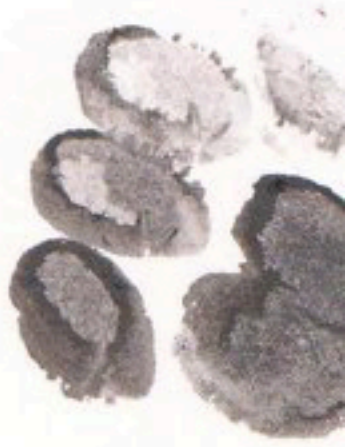
All the dogs sit on a table in a neat line. There should be no barking, no wriggling and absolutely no bottom sniffing.

Everyone says what their dog's name is and what their dogs are good at.

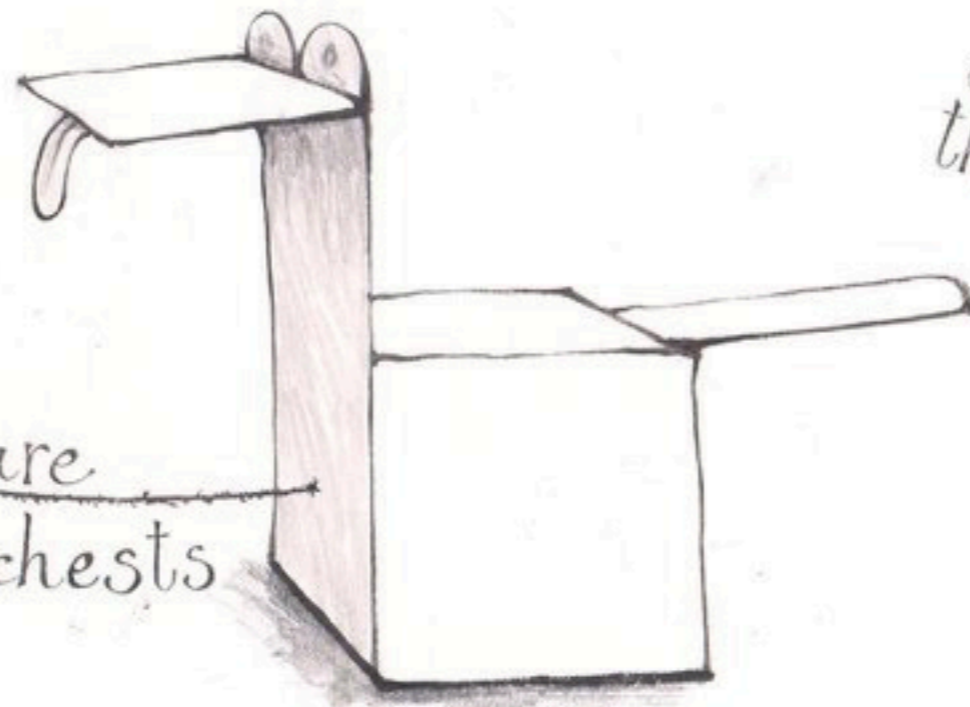
Now each dog should do the following tricks (lucky they are on leads so the owners can help)

4. Finish by doing an amazing acrobatic trick of the owner's choosing.

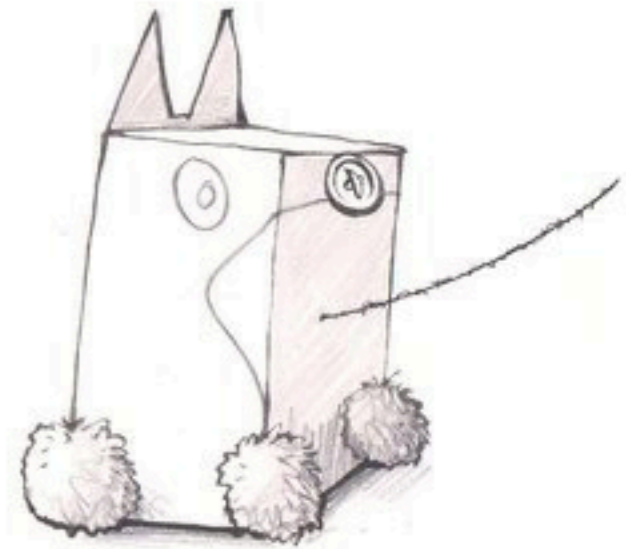
Remember to give your adorable mutt a treat whenever he/she does a great job.

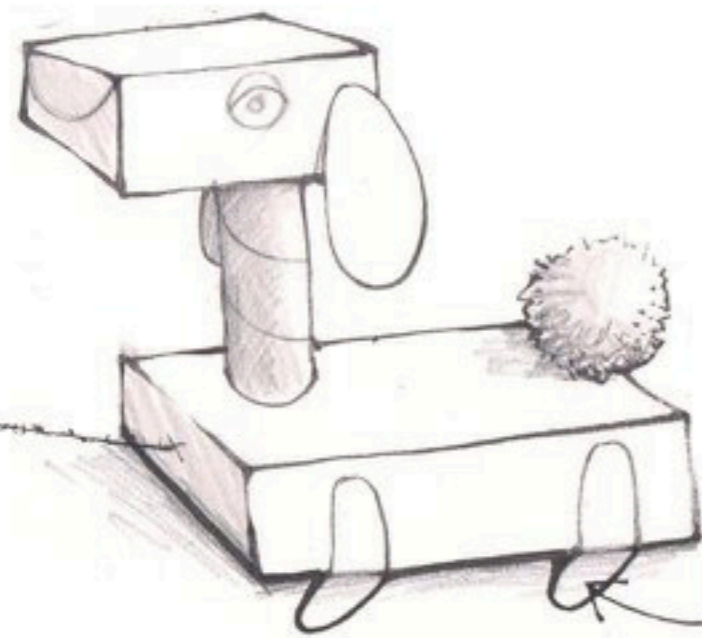
